

# SUNDAY SCHOOL TEACHER

The Sunday school teacher is a shepherd of the class and is responsible for keeping watch over the flock, providing spiritual nurture through biblical instruction, guidance and positive role modeling.

## ANTICIPATED TIME COMMITMENTS

- **Doing ministry/preparing for ministry:** three hours a week

## RESPONSIBILITIES/DUTIES

- Work with the Director of Student Ministries to choose curriculum for your class.
- Study and prepare for each weekly lesson.
- Pray for class members and visitors.
- Arrive 15 minutes before class begins to make sure classroom is prepared and to greet students as they arrive.
- Lead each week's class and involve teens in studying and learning God's Word through various teaching methods and activities.
- Utilize the assistant teacher: let them teach (help them prepare if necessary), participate, and plan things.
