3. In what ways does giving allegiance to Christ's kingdom force us to lay down our own kingdoms? Why is that such a struggle for people? What areas in your life are clinging to rather than laying them down under His authority?
4. Mary gave her very best to Jesus, because she knew He was worthy of it. What is your very best? Do you consider Jesus to be worthy of it? What would it look like for you to give it to Him?
