4. How would you respond to someone who you admire washing your feet? How would you feel about washing the feet of someone who you knew wanted to hurt you?
5. In what ways can we "wash the feet" of our brothers and sisters? What are tangible ways you can serve someone by setting your pride/dignity aside? How would this communicate the gospel?
