

# God is Enough, No Matter What Happens

Psalm 27

July 21, 2019

BIG IDEA: Because of his LORD, David is confident, focused, secure and waiting on his LORD. Personal “I, me, my” **46** x

- 1. Confident** in my LORD (1-3) not **anxious** and fearful  
“The LORD is my light and my salvation” (Psa. 62:1; 118:14)  
**Jesus** the “Light of the world” (John 8:12; 9:5; 12:46)  
Evil men advancing “to devour my flesh” (see also Job 19:22)  
The **terror** of words = carnivorous critics  
Evil men + enemies and foes + an army + war against **me**
- 2. Focused** on my LORD (4-6) not **distracted**  
A single-minded focus is extremely **rare** these days  
To contemplate the LORD’s **grace**, His perfections  
David wants to **hang out** at God’s dwelling place, temple, tent, shelter, rock, tabernacle, etc. a safe place  
Resulting sacrifice not of animals, but of praise (Heb. 13:15)  
Joyful thanksgiving in **song** and **music**
- 3. Secure** in my LORD (7-12) not **abandoned** or rejected  
Is David’s heart speaking or is God speaking to his heart? (8)  
Either way the **initiative** is with God.  
Impassioned plea **never** to be forsaken (Heb. 13:5)  
**Worship** in His presence and **walk** in His ways
- 4. Waiting** on the LORD (13-14) not performing or producing  
“I am still **confident** of this ” faith encouraging faith  
Waiting takes strength and **gives** strength (Isa. 40:31)  
“take heart” = **courage** to trust God alone (Josh. 1:9)
