## 1. The process broken down into **steps** (Rom. 10:14-16)

send—preach—hear—believe—call on Christ and be saved!

A one minute brief encounter, Ask a new friend, “Can I share with you how Jesus Christ has changed my life?”

Before I met Jesus I was \_\_\_\_\_ (your own story)

Then I met Jesus and now I am \_\_\_\_\_ (your own story)

## 2. Many ways to present the good news, all involve **words**

a) Jason Emmanuel Petty, stage name “Propaganda”

b) Ray Comfort at livingwaters.com (Romans 3:20)

c) **Invite** to church or small group or special event

Why invite others? So they could experience Christian community and begin, or strengthen, a relationship with Jesus. **82% of unchurched say they are “somewhat likely” to go if invited.**

d) The **Romans** Road

- All have sinned (Romans 3:23)
- Sin brings **death** (Romans 6:23a)
- Christ died for sinners (Romans 5:8 and 6:23b)
- Believe and **speak** out the truth (Rom. 10:9-10)
- Call on the name of the Lord and be saved (Rom. 10:13)
