God let His heart break at Calvary to heal our souls

1. Blinded by Details

In the presence of the world's most stupendous moment it is still possible for people to be unmoved. Holy contradiction: God's holiness cannot tolerate sin. but that same holiness causes Him to forgive it.

2. Anxious to Disprove

It's not a question of whether or not we're satisfied with the conditions of salvation, but whether God is satisfied with the means of our salvation.

3. Unnerved by the Truth

God the Father turned His back on His Son and let Him go through the horror of separation so I would never have to.

The Resurrection was the Father's guarantee that the debt I owe as a sinner was satisfied.
