Main idea: As believers in Jesus Christ, we all have a role to play in proclaiming the good news of the gospel.

Example of Jeremiah

Jeremiah was called to a specific and challenging role

Jeremiah was rejected and persecuted because of his obedience to God's calling on his life

Jeremiah had doubts about his ability to achieve his calling

Jeremiah was faithful to his calling

Lessons for us today

- God calls each believer to participate in his mission but one's specific calling may look different than another's.
- God's call may seem impossible and we might have many doubts about our ability to carry it out, but God will give us his grace to do His work.
- God seeks our faithful obedience to his call and promises to be with us.

On Your Own (better with others)

- 1) Have you sought out God's call for your life and the role you ought to play in sharing the gospel with those who need to hear it?
- 2) The need to share the Gospel message exists in homes and families, but also exists in our workplaces, with our non-Christian friends, throughout our city and country and extends throughout the entire world. What are some specific areas in which God may be calling you to share the good news of Jesus?
- 3) The Gospel (good news of Jesus) is the power of God unto salvation for all who believe (Romans 1:16). It restores mankind's broken relationship with God because of sin. How do these truths impact the need for your obedience to God's missional calling and the urgency with which you ought to share it?
- 4) Jeremiah had doubts about being able to fulfill his calling. What doubts and/or objections do you face and how can you overcome them?
- 5) In the Great Commission, Jesus promised that He will be with us always (Matthew 28:20). How does this promise impact your obedience in sharing the Gospel? Are you truly trusting in His promise?
