
## Together by Design: God's Plan for His Church Metaphor #5 "Body" June 13, 2021

The church is where the Holy Spirit brings together believers in Jesus according to God's design.

- 1. Don't add to the metaphor trying to be clever or cute
- 2. All six metaphors are about relationships
- 3. Relationships in the body of Christ (1 Cor. 12:12-27)
  - A. Wholeness/integrity/oneness in the Spirit (12-13)
  - <sup>4</sup> There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to one hope when you were called; <sup>5</sup> one Lord, one faith, one baptism; <sup>6</sup> one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all (Ephesians 4:4-6).
    - Ethnic and socio-cultural <u>status</u> is transcended (John 4:7-10 and 7:37-38)
  - B. Belonging (14-20)
    - Inter connect ed"it would not cease to be part of the body . . ."
    - Interdependent (this is <u>funny</u>)
      "Where would the sense of hearing . . . smell be?"
  - C. <u>Mutuality</u> (21-26)
    - Special honor —weaker; less honorable/presentable
    - <u>Equal</u> concern—for all who suffer or rejoice (see also Rom. 12:15)
  - D. Conclusion (27)
