3. What was the purpose of the two twelve stone memorials, one in the midst of the Jordan and the other on the land?
4. Have you built any memorials to God's marvelous deeds? Is this a good idea or not?
5. READ Psalm 107:8, 15, 21, 31 (NIV). The first line focuses on God's "unfailing love" and the second line on His "wonderful deeds." What connections can you find between His love and miracles?
6. *agree/disagree*  
The greatest danger to faith is forgetfulness (Psalm 103:2).
7. READ Exodus 25:10-22. The ark of the covenant is the presence of YHWH with His people. How is God described in Joshua 3:11&13?
8. READ John 1:14 and 2 Cor. 6:16 and Rev. 21:3. How do Christians experience the presence of God without the ark of the covenant?
