AMAZING VICTORY (10:12,13)

- o **Nothing is impossible** for God
- As believers we should expect **great personal victory in our walk with God**

BEHIND EVERY VICTORY (10:40-42; 11:21-30)

- o Joshua teaches us not to let **short term gains** detract us from **long term objectives**
- o Understanding the need to **visibly encourage others** is an essential aspect in **the growth of discipleship**

*“As opportunities come up, let's do good to everyone, beginning especially, with our brothers and sisters in faith (Gal 6:10)”*

- o There is a **step by step priority of order** in accomplishing what God calls us to do
- o **Past failure** doesn't mean **defeat today**  
  
*“. . .one thing I do. I forget what is behind and work toward what is ahead. I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward (Phil 3:13,14)”*
- There is a difference between **believing in God** and **believing God**

*“Remember, I commanded you to be strong and brave. Don't be afraid, because the LORD your God will be with you everywhere you go (Josh 1:9)”*

- o Discipleship: **Completely obeying** what God has called us to do as His people
