## God's Sovereign Grace to Resistant People

"But Jonah ran away from the LORD . . . " (Jonah 1:3a)

INTRO—The book of Jonah is a great story, but it is also a record of historical happenings around 770BC. Jesus referred to Jonah twice (Matthew 12:41 and Luke 11:29-32). The miracle of Jesus' resurrection and His preaching are similar to, but greater than, anything happening in the true story of the prophet named Jonah.

- 1. The unexpected <a href="blessing">blessing</a> of a word from the LORD (Jeremiah 1:4-5; Hosea 1:1; Micah 1:1; Joel 1:1; etc.)
- 2. The unexpected assignment to people under judgment
- 3. The unexpected response of God's prophet (Psalm 139:7-9)
  - I can't think of a single reason to obey
  - So, God must not have a reason
  - Therefore, obedience is unreasonable
- 4. What kind of a God do you want? (see Psalm 135:5-6)
- 5. Satan always provides a 'ship' to avoid obeying God
- 6. Once you're on the run from God, you go full 180°
  - a. Sent to Ninevah to the NE, Jonah heads west
  - b. Sent to a great city, Jonah goes to the world's edge
  - c. Sent on a trip overland, Jonah gets on a boat
- 7. Two ways to avoid doing God's will
  - a. Willful ignorance (Romans 1:18-19)
  - b. Strict keeping of the letter of the <u>law</u> (Hosea 6:6)

Jonah's on the run, but God is one step ahead of him, and you!
