How to Recognize A Leader To Follow

- 1. **CALLING**. The Bible uses "calling" in several ways
 - a. God's general calling to <u>all</u> to repent and believe (Acts 2:38-39)
 - b. God's effectual calling of <u>some</u> to belong to Him (Romans 1:6)
 - c. God's specific calling of the saved to sanctification (Romans 1:7; 1 Corinthians 1:2)
 - d. God's <u>personal</u> calling of individuals to serve Him (Romans 1:1)

Noah, Abraham, Moses, Samuel, Isaiah, Jeremiah, the 12, etc.

- 2. **CHARACTER**. The Department of the **Interior**
 - a. Character is <u>consistent</u> under stress or calm (Job 1 and 2)
 - b. Character is who you <u>are</u> when no one is looking (Elisha's servant, Gehazi in 2 Kings 5)
 - c. Character flaws may be neutralized, but never eradicated (Abraham in Genesis 12 and 20)
 - d. Character makes a leader **credible**.

Paul lists qualities to be found in an elder's life 1 Timothy 3:1-7
Of the 14 listed: 12 are character and 2 are competence

3. **COMPETENCE**. The proven ability to perform at a high level.

Both "integrity of heart" (character) and also "skillful hands" (competence) are necessary in a godly leader (Psalm 78:72).

 Joseph was <u>God's</u> man with <u>God's</u> plan (Genesis 41:33-40)

- David had an army of skilled, spiritual, brave <u>warriors</u> (1 Chronicles 12)
- Daniel was a godly <u>intellectual</u> serving in exile (Daniel 1:17-20)

Is □ character or □ competence more important? Why?

Remember: the largest part of competency is working within one's spiritual gifting for God's glory and the good of others.

- 4. **CHEMISTRY**. Someone who improves the outlook, attitude, and performance of those around him on the same team.
 - a. Chemistry is most noticeable when it is absent
 - b. Some ministry teams simply do not work well (Acts 15:36-41)
