## **T**hanksgiving

A-C-**T**-S

Psalm 30

Jan. 25, 2024

Thanks is the response of a Christ-follower to God's salvation.

1. Thank you God for rescuing me from <u>circumstances</u> (1-5)

You **hauled** me up from the depths (Psalm 69:2; 130:1)

You healed me from sickness "Doctors treat, God heals"

You helped me narrowly escape from death

Congregational singing of the **saved** 

Sorrow checks out and joy comes to stay (Ps. 126:5-6)

Being saved from sickness is not the same as being saved from sin, but one may lead to the other (see Luke 17:11-19).

2. Thank you God for rescuing me from <u>self</u> (6-10)

You see through my false security and boasting

You sustain my **fragile** existence (Psalm 104:29)

God, there's no benefit to you if I can't worship!

Commit self (and others) to God's mercy

Being saved from self is very close to being saved from sin, because self-righteousness will keep you from coming to Jesus.

3. Thank you God for rescuing me from **silence** (11-12)

You turned my wailing to dancing

You removed my sackcloth and clothed me with joy

You gave me a song

"Oh LORD my God, I will give you thanks forever."

Being saved from silence and having a song of praise or story of how God saved you (testimony) is evidence of a changed heart.

## On Your Own (Better with Others)

- 1. From today's sermon, what is one insight, observation or principle that you found helpful, eye-opening, or troubling?
- 2. How has God rescued you from dire circumstances, reliance upon yourself, and silence? Choose one and give Him thanks.
- 3. READ Philippians 4:4-7. What does it mean to pray "with thanksgiving?" Is thanksgiving an appetizer, a garnish, a side dish, the entre, or dessert ©? Is thanks extra or essential?
- 4. Do the angels give thanks? Is there thanksgiving in heaven? Will we ever stop giving thanks to God? (use Scripture in answer)
- 5. Where is it easier for you to offer thanksgiving to God for his many blessings; privately in your prayers to God, or publicly in corporate worship with others?
- 6. Do you have a favorite song of thanksgiving to God, a praise chorus or a hymn? (If with others, maybe sing it together.)
- 7. READ Philippians 1:3-6; Colossians 1:3-6; 1 Thessalonians 1:2-3 and thank God for brothers and sisters in Christ and His work in and through them. Spend some time thanking Him for others.
