Questions for Further Discussion:

(Great for Life Groups, family devotionals, or with a friend)

- 1. We often gravitate toward people who are most like us. Over time, this behavior can lead to mistrust, discrimination, and prejudice toward those we perceive as being unlike us. In Christian community we are called to celebrate what we have in common and see beyond our differences. Rank the following differences from 1 to 5 on your ability to engage and interact with someone... (1=really easy, 5=really hard)

 - > Who has a different educational background
 - > Who is at a different financial status
 - > Who holds different religious beliefs
 - > Who looks different (hair, fashion, body art, etc.)
 - > Who is in a different political party
 - > Who is from a different culture
 - > Who has different views on divisive social issues
 - Who is differently abled than yourself (physically or mentally)
 - > Who lives by vastly different morals & values
 - > Who has different ideas about health, diet, fitness
 - > Who is in a different age group
