(Great for Life Groups, family devotionals, or with a friend)

1. Life coming from death is one of the paradoxes of Jesus' kingdom and ministry? What are some other ways that life in his kingdom seems to contradict the ways of the world?
2. What does it mean to die to yourself? To "hate" this life in order to gain eternal life? What are some areas of life you need to sacrifice to grow in obedience?
3. How does our obedience to God bring him glory? How could others see God's glory by your obedience? Which commands regarding life in the kingdom are hardest for you to obey?
4. Jesus says that he will draw all people to himself. He also says that there is not much time left to escape the darkness. Have you trusted Him and left the darkness for His light? Do you know someone who needs to be reminded that this decision is life changing and urgent? How can you be like Andrew and Philip and take them to Jesus?
